Hill loch fishing for quality brown trout is also available. The area is world famous for deer stalking and Kerrow provides excellent accommodation, with all the extras to make a stalking break memorable. Golf is never far away in Scotland and there are many courses within an easy drive - five within 30 minutes!

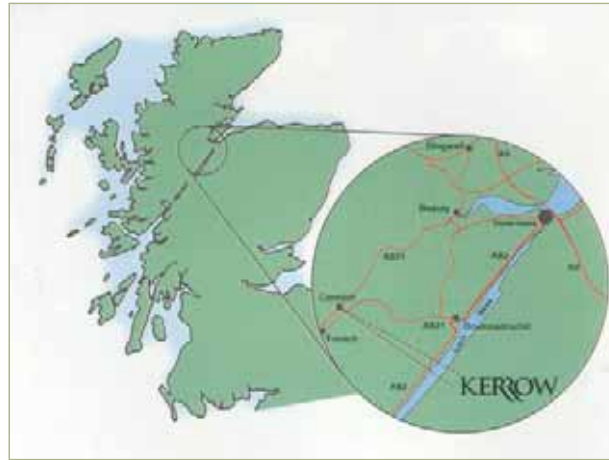


The nearby Glens of Affric, Cannich and Strathfarrar provide outstanding hill-walking, as well as being renowned for their stunning natural beauty and abundance of wildlife. The walks range from easy to the more testing Munros, please ask for guidance. Mountain bikes can be hired at Kerrow.



Pony-trekking is available from our stables; guests' horses and ponies can also be accommodated at Kerrow, for those wishing to bring their own mounts to ride.

Visitors wishing to explore this part of Scotland will find many interesting and easy day trips around the area. Visiting 'Nessie' at Drumnadrochit is a must. Visits to Inverness, the Battlefield at Culloden, the Castles and Priors of Moray and Nairn make enjoyable day-trips; whilst the rugged west coast is only ninety minutes away. #### How to get here

Take A82 from Inverness (signposted Fort William) along Loch Ness to Drumnadrochit. Turn right at the Loch Ness Monster Exhibition onto A831 through Glenurquhart towards Cannich. After about 12 miles and coming down a long hill turn left onto a single track road towards Tomich; after a mile go right on the driveway to Kerrow House.

Arrangements can be made to collect guests from Inverness, where there is an Inter-City rail terminal and an International airport; however a car is advised for full enjoyment of the area.

**Kerrow**, a traditional Georgian Hunting Lodge of the Chisholm style, was at one time home to the Highland author Neil

Gunn. It is set in 12 acres of woodland on the bank of the River Glass. An ideal base for touring and enjoying some of Scotland's finest scenery, whilst our stylish informality makes it perfect for a relaxing break.

All properties have been refurbished and up-graded recently to ensure the highest quality of holiday accommodation. The self-catering properties and Bed & Breakfast

rooms in Kerrow House are available throughout the year, being well insulated and heated for guests' comfort.



The self-catering properties are fully equipped, all have colour TV, a modern kitchen with microwave, and a bathroom with bath and shower. There is a central laundry by the main house.



**Riverside Cottage** has a spacious open-plan living room/kitchen with a wood-burning stove to supplement the inclusive night storage heating, and a patio overlooking the river.

There is a double and a twin bedroom and a modern bathroom. **Sleeps 4.**



**Fisherman's Cottage** is a large one-bedroomed cottage of great charm and comfort. There is a spacious, beautifully decorated living room with a wood-burning stove which augments the inclusive night storage heating, and an integral kitchen. Next to the double/twin bedroom is a bathroom. **Sleeps 2.**



**Birchwood & Rowan** are classic A-frame chalets, with a twin and double bedroom upstairs. The sitting room incorporates a dining area, with adjoining kitchen and bathroom, there are patio doors onto the large veranda.

Full central heating and electric fires ensure warmth throughout the winter. Heating/ power by Meter. Each **sleeps 4.**

**The Stalkers' Wing** is a completely self-contained wing of Kerrow House and has its own private entrance. Traditionally furnished, it is ideal for large groups or families looking for the Country House' atmosphere.



Accommodation consists of two double, a twin and a bunk bedroom, and a large bathroom upstairs. On the



ground floor is a kitchen/diner and utility with a washing machine and freezer. There is a good sized sitting room with a wood-burning stove to assist the central heating, which is provided at no charge. There is a separate shower-room and WC. Heating/ power by Meter. **Sleeps 8.**



**Bed & Breakfast** accommodation is available in the main house. There are three lovely rooms - one with a traditional four-poster bed, and a family room with a double and a single bed.



All have private facilities with shower or bathrooms: each bedroom has a colour TV and tea/coffee making equipment, a camp bed and a cot are also available.

Breakfast is continental or full cooked.
